ANNUAL ACTIVITIES REPORT FOR THE YEAR 2021-2022

1. PROTECTIVE AND REHABILITATIVE HOME UNDER UJJAWALA

With the financial assistance from Ministry of Women & Child Development, Govt. of India, this Organisation has been running HESI Protective and Rehabilitative (P&R Home) under Ujjawala (A Comprehensive Scheme for Prevention of Trafficking and Rescue, Rehabilitation and Re-integration of Victims of Trafficking for Commercial Sexual Exploitation) at Oinam Bazar, Bishnupur District since 1st October, 2013. The components of the project implemented by this Organisation are:

- i) Prevention
- ii) Rescue
- iii) Rehabilitation.

The following activities have been undertaken under the above components :

I. PREVENTION :

(a) Formation of Community Vigilance Group

3 (three) nos. of Community Vigilance Group were formed consisting of members representing community leaders, local CBOs women organisation etc. The community Vigilance Group had been given responsible for engagement of informer, networking meeting and awareness generation in local level.

(b) Formation and functioning of Balika (adolescents girls)/Balala (adolescent children) Sanghas

3 (three) nos. of Balika (adolescents girls)/Balala (adolescent children) Sanghas were formed at Nambol Kongkham, Irengbam and Oinam Makha Leikai, Bishnupur District where problem of trafficking is considerably high.

(c) Sensitization workshops/Seminars

The Organisation had organised 2 (two) days Workshop/Seminar at Leimaram, Bishnupur District for Stake holder, community leaders, Judiciaries, law enforcement agencies etc.

(d) Awareness generation through media including kalajathas, street plays, puppetry or through any other art forms, preferably traditional.

Awareness generation were carried out through street plays, puppetry, folk dance and cable networks etc. for general public covering maximum areas of project site.

(e) Development and printing of awareness generation materials such as pamphlets, leaflets and posters hoardings, advertisement etc.

Leaflet, Poster, and pamphlet in different dialect particularly Manipuri and English were published and distributed to the public. Poster, hoarding will be displayed at the public places.

II. RESCUE

(a) Information gathering communication

Informers were engaged to get information for trafficking in time so as to enable the implementing agency - HESI to take up rescue operation.

(b) Rescue operation

Rescue operation were carried out by a rescue team networking with Police, Legal Experts, Childline, women organisation, Child welfare committee, Juvenile Justice Board, Women protection officer etc. During the period 3 girls have been rescued.

(c) Immediate Relief on Rescue

Basic amenities such as meal, food, shelter, toiletries, clothing, trauma care/ counselling, medical health check up etc. were provided to victims.

III. REHABILITATION

(a) Setting up of Potective Homes

A Protective Home for 50 (fifty) inmates (at a point of time) has established at Oinam Bazar, Bishnupur District, Manipur.

(b) Basic amenities

Basic amenities such as meal, food, shelter, toiletries, clothing, trauma care/ counselling, medical health check up etc. were provided to victims.

(c) Medical Care (medicine includes emergency care)

Regular health check-up, provision of medicine for minor ailment reference service for complicated cases to the Govt. Hospital.

(d) Legal Aid

Counselling by legal experts, and attending court cases, Legal aid were provided to the victims with the help of Legal experts.

(e) Education

Non-Formal Education and efforts were made for reintegration of education.

(f) Vocational Training and Income Generation activities

Vocational training for economic empowerment, Self help group, rehabilitation and social re-integration.

The following vocational training programme were conducted:

- (i) Handicraft training cum production
- (ii) Food processing and preservation training cum production
- (iii) Training programme on Soft Toy Making.
- (iv) Training on Beauticulture

3. CHILDREN HOME:

The Organisation has been running two Children Home namely "HESI Children Home" for 100 destitute children for girls at Khurai Nandeibam Leikai, Imphal East District, and "Lairembi Sanglen Children Home" for 50 destitute children for girls at Chingdong Leikai, Jiribam, Jiribam District, Manipur under the sponsorship of integrated child protection scheme (ICPS), Ministry of Women and Child Development, Government of India. The Organisation got registered under Juvenile Justice (Care and Protection of Children) Amendment Act, 2006 under Social Welfare Department, Government of Manipur and recognised as Fit Organisation for reception of children who are in need of care and protection. The Home provided following services like free fooding & lodging, Bridge Education, Vocational education through tie-up with NGOs, JSS etc, Health care facilities, Recreational facilities and Counselling/Psychological support to children.

4. OPEN SHELTER HOME:

The Organisation has been running a Open Shelter Home for destitute girl Children at Thngkaiphai Saikul Bazar, Kangpokpi District under the sponsorship of integrated child protection scheme (ICPS), Ministry of Women and Child Development, Government of India. During the period under report 25 inmates have been provided free fooding, counselling service recreational facilities, healthcare services and vocational education.

5. SENIOR CITIZEN WELFARE PROGRAMME

Senior citizen welfare programme is one of the regular continuation programmes of the organisation. This Organisation had conducted 3 days health check up programme at Saikul Bazar, Kangpokpi District, Manipur. During the programme 35 older persons including men and women were benefited. Recreation facilities, health care, counselling services and distribution of cloths have been provided to 25 older persons during the period under report.

6. MOBILE MEDICARE UNIT

The Organisation has been running a mobile medicare unit at Jiribam District to the welfare programme of senior citizens. The main activities of this programme is to improve the health status of the rural poor senior citizens. During the period under report 345 senior citizens were benifitted health check-up facilities.

7. VOCATIONAL TRAINING PROGRAMME ON EMBROIDERY/TAILORING

The Organisation had conducted 3 months vocational training programme on embroidery/tailoring at Khurai Nandeibam Leikai, Imphal East District, Manipur from 1st September to 31st November, 2021. The main objective of the programme were to improve the skill level as well as to uplift the income level through skill upgradation of unemployed youths. Various experts and trainer taught during the vocational training programme. Raw materials were provided at free of cost during the programme. Altogether 25 selected beneficiaries were benefitted through the said training programme.

8. PLANTATION OF MEDICINAL PLANT

During the period under report the Organisation has identified different rare medicinal plant with the help of State Medicinal Plant Board and these identified medicinal and aromatic plants have been planted on the community wasteland areas of Taorem Village, Imphal East District, Manipur. The main objective of the programme was to improve the health status of tribal masses through Traditional System of Medicine.

9. WELFARE PROGRAMME FOR DISABLE PERSONS

As a part of Handicapped/Disabled person welfare programme, the Human Empowerment for Social Integration had selected 30 handicapped/disabled persons with high percentage from Imphal East District and distributed hearing aid, 2 wheel chairs, 5 walking sticks and 2 pairs of crutch were distributed on 10th January, 2022 as a part of world disable day. The disable/handicapped persons and their family members were also provided counseling to help themselves for their future life.

10. AGRI & HORTICULTURE DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME

With a view of improving the poor and marginal farmer through modernisation of agriculture and horticulture, the organisation had conducted 5 days farmers training programme on scientific methods of farming at Tangkham, Imphal East District from 7th July 2021 to 11th July, 2021. The contents of this programme were introduction to new methods of farming, use of organic manure, selection and preparation of seeds. Control of pest and disease, role of different department and other necessary post harvest activities. The training programme was participated by 30 farmers from different part of Imphal East District. Noted plant pathologist and agricultural scientist from ICAR and CAU had been providing their valuable service during the said programme.

11. SWASTHA BHARAT MISSION

A one day Swastha Bharat Mission programme at Khurai Nandeibam Leikai, Imphal East District on 23th November, 2021. Resource persons delivered talk on the issues of environment, bio-diversity, conservation of forest and health and hygiene of surrounding area. Social Service is also part of the programme. 55 Children took part in the programme.

12. TRANSGENDER WELFARE PROGRAMME

The Organisation had conducted two days workshop/seminar on Transgender at Youth Hostel, Khuman Lampak, Imphal East District, Manipur from 19th and 20th November, 2021. Resource persons from concerned Social Welfare department, police personnel, social worker etc. Various legal experts delivered talk relating to human rights and gender violence. 35 Transgender took part in the programme.

10. SKILL TRAINING PROGRAMME

a) FASHION DESIGNING

The Organisation had conducted a week long training programme on Fashion designing at Khurai Nandeibam Leikai, Imphal East District, Manipur on

1st October, 2021 to 7th October, 2021. The main objective of the training programme was to improve the income level of the poor rural girls through skill upgradation and creation of self employment. During the reporting year, 20 selected girls from different parts of Imphal East District had successfully completed the training programme. The trainees were also provided raw materials and other necessary equipment during the training at free of cost.

b) HAND EMBROIDERY

The Organisation has conducted 5 days Hand Embroidery training programme at its Head office located at Khurai Nandeibam Leikai, Imphal East District, Manipur. The main objective of programme is to bring economic sustainability among the rural unemployed women/girls through capacitating and technical support. During the reporting year, 15 numbers of unemployed women/girls from different parts of Imphal East District took part in training programme on handloom. The trainees were also provided raw materials and other necessary equipment during the training at free of cost.

c) CARPENTRY

The Organisation had conducted one month long Carpentry training programme at Khurai Chaithabi Leirak, Imphal East District (1st May, 2021 to 30th May, 2021). The main objective of this programme is to improve socio-economic status of poor youths through skill upgradation in the trade of Carpentry. Under this programme, 30 selected youths including 5 girls had successfully completed the training.

d) BEAUTICULTURE

The Organisation had conducted a 4 weeks long Beauticulture Development programme on make-up training at Khurai Lamlong Bazar, Imphal East District, Manipur. Under this programme 40 selected poor rural women have been benefitted by imparting training on make-up and as a follow up action.

e) COMPUTER

The Organisation had conducted 2 months long computer training programme at Khurai Lamlong Bazar, Imphal East District, Manipur during the period under report. 30 selected youths successfully completed computer training programme of basic knowledge of DOS, WINDOWS, Tally, and DTP operation etc. Certificates were distributed to the trainees after completion of computer training programme.
